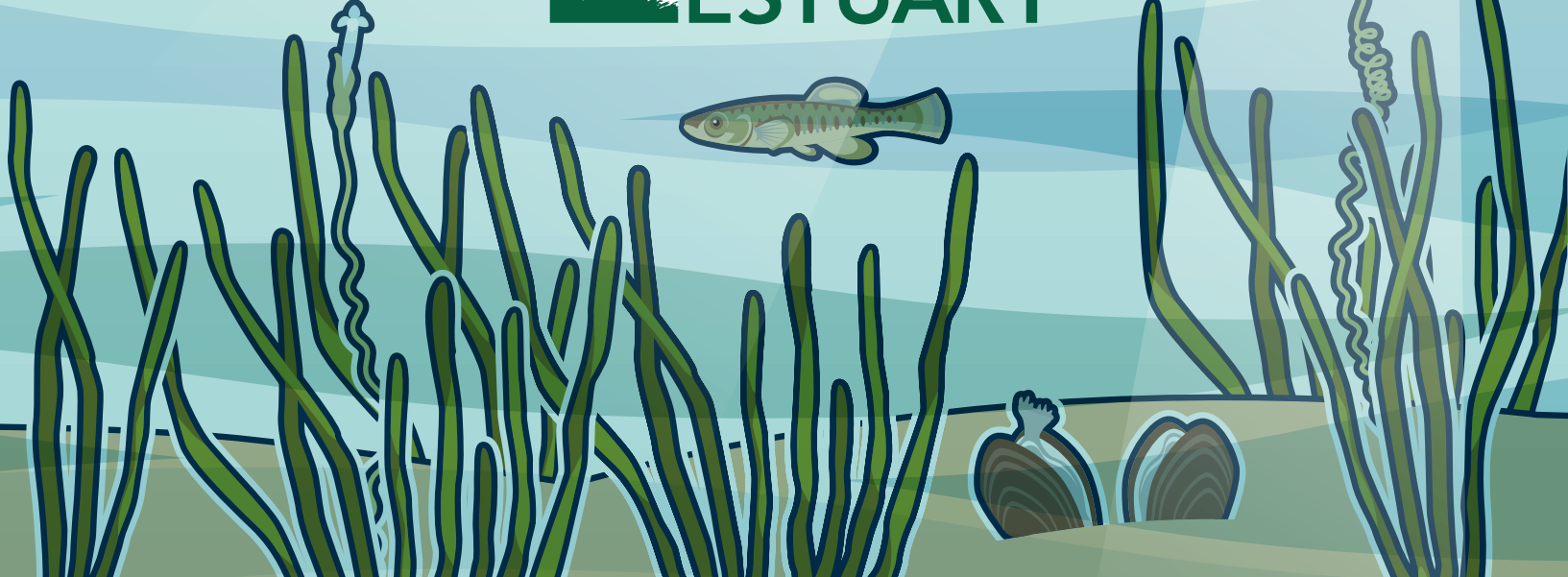

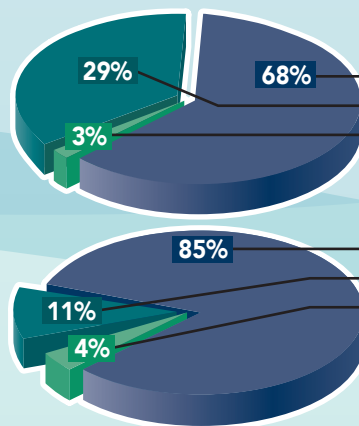

2025 Highlights

Monitoring Shorelines

In April, PDE science staff conducted monitoring in Lewes, DE at the Canary Creek, where a camera was installed along its banks.



Mussel Rehoming

This summer, 1,850 hatchery-raised freshwater mussels were rehomed by PDE staff and partners who carefully placed the tagged mussels in the Delaware River.



Mussels in Ponds

This summer, PDE and The Watershed Institute placed baskets of juvenile mussels in a NJ pond, where their impact on biodiversity will be studied.



Oyster Shell Bagging

Over 75 volunteers supported PDE's shell bagging program in 2025, making more than 3,200 shell bags, each weighing in at approximately 20 lbs!



Delaware River Festival

Over 2,500 people joined the fun in Philly and Camden, NJ, with 30+ environmental groups, ferry and pedal boat rides, and an exciting bird show.



Schuylkill Scrub and Pub

66 Schuylkill Action Network volunteers helped keep Pennsylvania beautiful by collecting 3,350 lbs. of trash — that's about the weight of a hippo!



2025 Highlights

Education Programs with Kids

More than 80 elementary school students enjoyed hands-on activities and nature walks led by PDE education staff at Cool Spring Park in Wilmington.



Oyster Shell Recycling

PDE collected over 40,000 pounds of shell from DE and PA restaurants this year. Since 2014, we've recycled shell for use in restoration projects.



Chester River Festival

Casting lessons were a highlight at the 2025 Chester River Festival, which was held just steps away from the banks of the Delaware River.



Christina River Cleanup

Volunteers at 14 sites throughout New Castle County collected tons of trash. PDE and the City of Wilmington co-hosted a cleanup site in the city neighborhoods.



Acoustic Monitoring in Marshes

PDE scientists collected 239,300 2-minute audio recordings this field season, tuning into marsh soundscapes — capturing birds, bugs, boats, airplanes, and more.



20th Anniversary of Summit

In February, PDE's Science and Environmental Summit featured over 70 presentations and a special dinner honoring U.S. Senator Thomas R. Carper.
